Sevenoaks Camera Club's 2025 Exhibition

Sevenoaks Kaleidoscope Gallery again hosts Sevenoaks Camera Club's Annual Exhibition, showing from 16 to 26 July. This is another opportunity to see the work of local enthusiast photographers. The exhibition displays some of our members' favourite work including landscapes, portraits, natural history, abstract and more.

The Sevenoaks Kaleidoscope Gallery is at Buckhurst Lane, Sevenoaks TN13 1LQ and the exhibition is open during normal Sevenoaks Library opening times from Wednesday 16 July until Saturday 26 July 2025. Admission is free. The Gallery website is www.svaf.co.uk/sevenoaks-kaleidoscope-art-gallery/

Prints will be on display every day of the show. On Saturdays there will also be a display of the digital photo section on a TV screen and members of the club will be in attendance to answer questions. As well as the main gallery display, on the mezzanine area we will be showing a selection of railway-related prints to coincide with Railway 200 celebration, and also some triptychs by members.

The Club's members include both relative beginners and more experienced photographers; they use many types of cameras including mobile phones. Some members no longer take photos but just enjoy seeing good pictures and listening to our speakers. Meetings usually take place on three Mondays a month between September and May and include talks about photography by members and visiting speakers, good-natured competitions, and also some workshops. The friendly meetings help members to enjoy photography and improve their skills in various ways. FACTS ABOUT SEVENOAKS CAMERA CLUB

- Established 1952
- We have nearly 50 members at all levels from relative beginners to very experienced; some members are no longer active photographers but come to meetings to appreciate the photographs.
- We are not concerned about what camera is used.

- There are typically 25 to 30 meetings a year between September and May, on Monday evenings from 8 pm to 10 pm.
- Most meetings are held in person at Mencap Hall, Hitchen Hatch Lane, Sevenoaks, TN13 3AU.
- A few meetings (mainly in winter months) take place over Zoom.
- Talks by our own members and external speakers.
- Friendly competitions assessed by outside judges.
- We also organise a few informal outings, mostly during the summer.
- The 2025-26 individual subscription of £55 equates to about £2 per meeting; there are concessionary rates for joint memberships and students.
